GUIDELINES FOR POSTER DISPLAY

➤ Registration:

Presenting authors **MUST** register and pay for the conference by **Wednesday 10 June 2026**, to present and have their abstract published in the final programme. Click [HERE](#) to register now. The location of your poster will be published in the final programme, which will be published in the Conference App.

IMPORTANT

➤ Poster Preparation:

You are kindly required to prepare **(1) a printed poster AND (2) an electronic poster.**

➤ (1) Poster Dimensions for your **printed poster**:

- Orientation format: **Portrait**
- Poster maximum size: **119 cm in height and 84 cm in width (A0 format)**
- File format: **PowerPoint**
- It is **mandatory** to have your poster number / final ID (e.g. P123) at the top right of your poster.

➤ Poster Printing Services & Delivery

- Our provider (**PosterSessionOnline**) can **print and deliver your poster directly to the registration desk** at the convention centre!
- All poster authors will be contacted directly by the supplier at a later stage with details of the poster printing service, including a link to submit and pay for printing.
- If you wish to use this service, you will have until **7 September 2026 at 23:00 CEST** to upload your poster for printing.
- For further questions about this service, please contact the customer support customer@postersessiononline.eu
- If you do not wish to use our providers, you are free to choose any other printing services of your choice and bring the poster with you.

➤ (2) **Electronic poster**:

- You will also have to produce an **electronic poster (1 slide PowerPoint Portrait format)** as supporting material. Further guidelines on how to submit your e-poster, including a link with credentials to upload your poster, will be sent in August **by the ISQua Abstract Secretariat (MCI)**.
- It is **mandatory** to have your poster number / final ID (e.g. P123) at the top right of your poster.
- You may use the same file you have used for your printed poster.

➤ Poster Awards – Participation Criteria:

- A Poster Awards competition will take place. If you wish to participate, you must upload your digital poster no later than **4 September 2026 at 23:59 CEST**.
- Further instructions regarding the upload process will be shared with you in **August 2026**.

Poster Awards Criteria:

- Clarity of project and outcomes
- Robust methods and findings
- Relevance to improving quality and safety.
- Design - key points clearly stated.
- Use of graphics, photos, illustration

➤ **Rules and Regulations:**

- All posters must be printed/uploaded in **English**.
- Please ensure there is no material within your poster which could be seen as marketing a commercial product or Programme.

➤ **Waiver**

Submission constitutes your consent to publish your poster. **Please inform us if you do not wish your presentation to be posted** on the ISQua website following the conference.

➤ **Poster Display at the Conference:**

1. **Presence at your poster station**

Authors of accepted posters are requested to stand by their poster to be able to discuss it with participants during the 'Meet the Poster Presenters' Reception on Monday 28 September 2026, from 17:00 - 18:30 and during the lunch break mentioned in your notification letter.

2. **Poster boards:**

Each poster board is numbered, corresponding with your poster number / final ID, *e.g. P123*.
A list will be available onsite with the reference number, poster title and list of authors.

3. **Fixation:**

The material will be provided on-site at the Conference Poster Desk. Push pins, staples, etc., are NOT allowed.

4. **Set-up and dismantle:**

The authors are responsible for setting up and dismantling their posters according to the schedule.

➤ **Mounting and removing your poster:**

Posters should be displayed from Monday 28 September – Wednesday 30 September 2026.

Mounting: 8:00 - 10:00 on Monday 28 September 2026

Removal: Before 14:30 on Wednesday 30 September

Posters **must be removed no later** than **14:30 on September 30th**. After this time, they will be removed by staff, and no responsibility can be taken for their safe return.
